- 1) Because I am a member of the body of Christ, I must be a functioning member, whether I am an "eye," an "ear,", or a "hand." As a functioning member, I will give. I will serve. I will minister. I will share. I will learn. I will seek to lift up others. I will remember that "if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; if one member is honored, all the members rejoice with it" (I Cor. 12:26)
- 2) I will seek to be a source of unity in my church. I know there are no perfect pastors, staff, or other church members. But neither am I. I will not be a source of gossip or dissension.

One of the greatest contributions I can make is to do all I can in God's power to help keep the unity for the sake of the gospel.

- 3) I will not let my church be about my preferences and desires. That is self-serving. I am a member in this church to serve others and to serve Christ. My Savior went to a cross for me. I can deal with any inconvenience and matters that just aren't my preference or style.
- 4) I will pray for my church family and leadership often.
- 5) I will lead my children to be healthy members of a local church with my words and actions so that they discover the joy of the community of Jesus and desire it for their adult lives wherever they end up. They will grow up seeing my commitment to others in the body in prayer, service, ministry, attendance and support.
